


The man took the racoon home and ask his wife to make soup with it.




**RACOON:** (Sweet voice)

The old woman believed him and let him free.






The racoon took the pestle and hit her on the head, killing her. But the rabbit had seen everything.

- Hi, racoon, will you help me to carry this hay? I'll give you a rice ball after that.


The racoon put the hay on his back and the rabbit lit a fire on it.

The racoon and the boat sunk to the bottom of the river.


